

PAC Meeting Minutes

12 people attended
Meeting started at 8:40 a.m.

Julie Potts welcomed everyone and opened the meeting in prayer.

Devotion was presented by Darcy Peterson from Proverbs 31 Ministry entitled "Weak Places, Strong Places".

An envelope was passed around for childcare donations.

The minutes from the November 5th meeting were passed.

Melanie Edwards gave the Financial Report. Revenue from the Applebees fundraiser was \$4527.80. Expenses from the Applebees fundraiser was \$462.88, giving the PAC a grand total of \$4064.92 raised. This is the most money the PAC has raised through the Applebees fundraiser in the 3 years we have done it!

Co-Presidents Julie Potts and Darcy Peterson thanked everyone for their donations, time and effort in helping make the Applebees fundraiser such a huge success. Thank you letters are being written and will be mailed to all of the businesses that donated items. Julie acknowledged Danielle Vaughn for her hard work in the getting so many donated items from Delta businesses and organizations.

Marty Flowers gave a summary of the upcoming Christmas Hayride on Friday, December 10th at 5:30 pm. The event will start at CWCS at 5:30. The families will walk over to Heidi's Chateau and sing to the residents. After singing, the children will pass out Christmas cards to the residents. From Heidi's Chateau, the CWCS families will load onto the hay trailers and ride over to Sunrise Living Center where they will sing their carols and pass out Christmas cards. A car will follow the trailers with hazard lights on. Following the ride back to CWCS, cookies and hot chocolate will be provided in the CWCS cafeteria. Mrs. Miller, music teacher, will be working on the Christmas carols during music next week with the younger children. Marty Flowers and Brandy Auker are having the children sign Christmas cards during their library time. If anyone has extra Christmas cards they are not using, please give them to Brandy or Marty to use! Fliers will be sent out through the classrooms next week and a phone call will be made to the school families on Wednesday evening.

Fundraiser earning allocation was discussed. A motion was made to give 10% of the total needed for teacher bonuses determined by CWCS school board.

Darcy and Julie will present the PAC donation at the next CWCS School Board meeting on December 13th.

Robbin Cogdill will be heading up a Capri Sun collection program for CWCS. Capri Sun will pay 2 cents per bag. She would like a special collection container in the lunch room for kids to drop Capri Sun bags in. Robbin would pick up the container each Friday and bring it back on the following Monday. Darcy and Julie will propose putting the Capri Sun collection container in the lunch room to the school board. Robbin will be sending a flier out through the classrooms in January that will cover all of the programs CWCS is enrolled in and how the CWCS families can participate and support.

Kenda Bruck reported on the Fundraising Committee. The Gift Wrapping Day at Genesis Book Store on November 27 went well. \$150 was raised and she felt a good working relationship was developed with Genesis for the future. The committee is currently holding one-on-one meetings with potential financial donors as well as developing a donation letter to be sent out to alumni of CWCS. The Fundraising Committee is praying about the direction God wants the committee to go.

Barb Kosten reported the Tuesday Hot Lunch program is going very well. Monthly food donations have been incredible and thanked all who have donated! One family donated all of the food needed from the December donation list! The January food donation list was not listed in the December school newsletter and so Barb passed the list around. We will post the January food donation list on the donation box in the school foyer.
