Meeting started at 8:33am

Darcy Peterson welcomed everyone to the meeting and opened in prayer.

Brandy Auker's devotion was called "If I Were a Goose". A short story about the true meaning of Christmas.

The Childcare donation envelope was passed around.

The minutes from the October 7th meeting were approved by the committee.

Mr. Fell provided us with an Administrator Report. The school is very thankful for the Bronco fundraiser and the hard work of the families selling tickets. The financial stability of the school is improving. A local church raised their monthly contribution to CWCS to \$2200 through May! As of now, the school is good through March to meet their monthly bill obligation. Teacher status for next year: unsure if Miss Farrier will be returning and Mrs. Burr will be retiring at the end of the school year. He has already received some resumes. The CWCS School Board would like input from PAC members on the way tuition, registration fees and book fees are collected to avoid the situation we experienced this year. PAC members in attendance made suggestions. On Tuesday, December 6, JoAnne Sellers from Alabama Foundations and Frameworks will be sitting in each of our classrooms observing teachers instructing on Foundations and Frameworks. Following school that day, she will meet with the faculty to discuss observations and give feedback.

The Broncos fundraiser ends on Monday. Totals were just under \$25,000.00 this past Monday. An assembly will be held in the Chapel at 2:35 to draw the winning ticket.

Darcy discussed the Applebee's Fundraiser and confirmed that at this moment the tentative date is Saturday, February 11, 2012. Discussion was held on whether to do the class basket auction and it was decided by vote to not have the class baskets this year due to extra financial obligations to the school families. Instead, we will focus our efforts on getting business or personal donations for the \$1.00 drawing tickets and will auction off any larger gift basket donations. Hillary Brubaker and Darcy Peterson will be in charge of doing a letter to the school families letting them know of the changes to this year's Applebees and also welcoming them to donate items for the drawings or auction. Karmen Freeland volunteered to help on this committee as well. Danielle Vaughn is in charge of donations committee. Julie Potts will be in charge of the servers/greeters committee.

Melissa Hall of the CWCS School Board has asked the PAC to provide either snacks or lunch for teachers on Monday, January 23, 2012 for a CPR class for all CWCS faculty. It was decided by vote of the attending members to provide a lunch of sub sandwiches, chips, cookies/brownies and water bottles. We will purchase it from the PAC funds.

No committee reports were given.

The floor was opened for volunteers for opening prayer and/or devotion for next meeting. Lori Lutz volunteered to do the prayer and devotion.

The January PAC meeting will be Friday, January 13, 2012 at 8:30 a.m. in the CWCS lunchroom.
