#### PAC DONATION APPROPRIATIONS

*The PAC will consider requests from CWCS teachers or staff for outlay of monies to fund events, activities, or purchase materials and supplies that benefit the majority of or the entire student body. This would include donating to regularly scheduled school classes including, but not limited to music, P.E., art, computer lab, or library.*

*Extra-curricular events will also be considered and would include such things as: informational speakers/presentations, performances, ceremonies, fundraisers, and charity events. For a donation to be considered, the outcome of benefiting the majority of or the entire student body, would be a requirement.*

*The PAC will have donation request forms available in the school office, which should be submitted 30 days prior to the next PAC meeting for inclusion in the agenda.*

Erin Berge was unable to attend today's meeting, so the Christmas Party / Parents Night Out will have to be decided via e-mail. So everyone be watching for that e-mail to see where you can help!

New Business: Lenni Jo Copeland has shared with us that some parents are committing to bringing in art supplies for the art program and then she never sees these items. She has had to then buy some of these item herself, which can add up quickly. We discussed that we could maybe make sure her needs are put in the newsletter each month, but the real issue is that we need to be sure to bring in those items and not leave her hanging.
